Re National Burn Awareness Day

Building on the success of a Burn Awareness Day run by the prevention committee of the British Burn Association in 2014, a further day has been organised to run in 2015 on the 21st October. Running up to this day efforts are being made by each of the 22 burn services in England and Wales to heighten the general awareness concerning burn injury and to engage with as many agencies and organisations as possible to take forward the burn prevention message. We would very much hope that you and your burn service would be interested in participating in this awareness effort on and around the 21st October.

In preparation for the day we have developed a number of pieces of information which have been updated to give a current overview of the causes of burn injury, the age groups affected and inevitably provide the best first aid information we can for injuries that have not been prevented. On the NBAD card (designed by Birmingham Children's Burn Service) there is space for you to enter your burn service name and trust, please do not amend the card. The cost of printing the card via your trust may be as little as £16.00 per 1,000 copies.

Please keep Cathy Reade informed about what you are planning for the day so that we might learn about what is effective to use in the run up to next year's Burn Awareness Day.
