#### Travelling South on the A23

(from Redhill) Follow signs to Gatwick from Redhill. Travelling on the dual carriageway through Salfords, head past the Harvester on your right-hand side and as you round

a slight bend in the road, turn left opposite Harwood Park (signposted Orchard Business Centre)
