St Robert of Newminster Feast Day Celebrations - **The annual walk to Newminster Abbey to celebrate St Robert's Feast Day will be at 3:30pm TODAY.** Prior to the walk (at 3:15pm), local historian, George Thornton, will deliver an introductory talk and then participants will walk from St Robert's (at 3.30pm) to Newminster Abbey where an Ecumenical Service of Evening Prayer will be held in the Abbey Grounds. Mr Thornton will then give some information about the site and give a short report on some very recent archaeological investigations that have been carried out. On our return to St Robert's, Afternoon Tea will be served in the Church Hall. **There will also be Mass on Tuesday 7th June at 7:00pm (the actual Feast Day) with a celebration afterwards in the church hall.**

The New Translation of the Missal - From September 2011 we shall be using a new translation of the Mass in all the Catholic Churches of this country. This will mean changes both in the words that the priests say and in the responses of the people. The structure of the Mass will NOT change. The Lectionary (Scripture readings) will NOT be changing. In our lifetime we live through many changes. It can be very uncomfortable but we need to be open to the opportunities that these changes can provide. At the back of Church you will find copies of the main parts of the Mass – THE ORDER OF MASS (yellow sheet). **The colour booklet – “Understanding the Revised Mass Texts” costs £2.**

“An Introduction to the new translation of the Mass” – A six week course from the people who brought us the *Great Adventure* and *St Matthew's Gospel*. A fascinating and inspiring series that highlights the biblical foundations of the Mass. Starts on Thursday 9th June at 7.00pm in the parish hall. All welcome.
