This relates to those who were last checked in 2007 so if you have not received a form, please do not worry. It is not your turn yet!! Because of the number of people involved it would be helpful if we could have a few "processing sessions" in the Presbytery, when the safeguarding officers can check and photocopy the required evidence and sign off the forms. The first two suggested dates are Tuesday August 16th from 6.30 to 7.30pm and Wednesday August 17th after morning Mass until 11.00am. We will arrange a further date in September to accommodate those who are away on holiday. It would be very helpful if you could look carefully at the notes supplied by the Diocese to help you. For example, you do not need to complete question A28 or any of Section D. You do need to complete A30. You do need to bring the "Confirmation of Identity" form and have completed that too. When looking at the types of evidence you need to bring to be photocopied, please remember to check the dates on utility bills and bank statements etc. On the back of the "Confirmation of Identity" form, it tells you whether these sorts of documents need to have been issued within the last three months, twelve months or whether it does not matter. If you have a passport and/or Driving Licence it is important that you actually use these as evidence. If your Driving Licence is the photocard style, do remember to bring the paper counterpart as it is not acceptable without. Thank you very much for taking time to do this.
