New Security Fence - In order to meet current regulations and guidance regarding the safeguarding of children, a need for a security fence on the church field has been identified. The field is an essential resource for the school in offering our children a wide range of outdoor activities. Without a security fence, regulations require a much higher ratio of supervising staff to children, which the school would be unable to resource. The Site Users Group (with representatives from the parish, the school and play group) have given much consideration to this proposal over the past year and researched the possible options. The Parish Council met on the 12th September 2011 with Mr Joe Hughes, Director of Education for the Diocese of Hexham and Newcastle, and after some considerable deliberations supported the proposal that a security fence be erected across the field from the far north western corner of the church (the corner of the church furthest away from the main entrance) across to the riverside fence. The fence will have both a pedestrian and a vehicle access gate. These gates will be locked only during the school day, and there will be free access to the field for the parish community at all other times. With the fence in this location, there will be full access for everyone to the church, the peace garden and the surrounding grassed area at all times. The design and construction of the fence will be in keeping with the existing church fencing. As a responsible and caring parish community, this fence will help us to promote the welfare and safety of our school children, who are the future of our Church, and ensure that they receive the best educational opportunities we can offer. The fence will be erected at no cost to the parish. The plans are available in the church hall. If you have any questions please speak to Fr Lawrence.

Young Adults Pilgrimage to the Holy Land led by Bishop Seamus Cunningham – Monday 27th February to Monday 5th March 2012 (for those aged 18 to 30) - Fr Lawrence is glad to announce that because of some very substantial donations (some from our parishioners) he is able to offer this pilgrimage for £600 each (two sharing) and is confident that he will be able to reduce it further. He awaits two replies from Trust funds and Religious Orders who have supported the pilgrimage in the past. £600 is for two sharing and will cover flights and half board accommodation in the Holy Land. It covers our guide and coach travel in the Holy Land and all entrance fees. Insurance (about £18) can be arranged through the Diocesan Insurers. It is estimated that lunch each day will cost £15 at the most. This is an opportunity not be missed. £100 deposit is needed. Once we know how many parishioners are coming we can also arrange fundraising in the parish.
