<u>Our Lady of Newminster Pilgrim Statue</u> – from May (month of Our Lady) to October (month of the Rosary). The statue is available to be resident in a home each week. Consecration of new altar and lectern and the rededication of the altar rails - Fr Lawrence is glad to announcer that a date has been set with Bishop Seamus – Thursday 27th June at 7 00pm. Put it in your diary. This will be a very important celebration for the parish and there will be festivities afterwards. – a hog roast and a marquee with lots of drinks. A lot of help will be needed at the time. It will be very similar to the Jubilee celebrations of Fr. Lawrence and Fr. Jim last year. Parishioners are requested to provide desserts and sweets.

<u>St Robert's Day Celebrations</u> - Friday 7th June. Mass in the church at 9 15am with St Robert's School. After Mass there will be a walk to the abbey grounds. In the evening there will be a **pie and pea supper and quiz in the church hall at 7.00pm. Tickets £5.00 each - available after Mass**. Please note that it is acceptable to have meat this day because in this parish St Robert's Feast Day is ranked as a "Solemnity" – like a Holy Day and is exempt from the abstinence regulations. Regulation is perhaps not the appropriate word given the fact that the Bishops of England and Wales have only "invited" the faithful to abstain from meat on a Friday and explicitly said that it is not a sin to eat meat on a Friday. But, let us not forget that we are obligated to do some form of Penance or good work on a Friday.

Fundraising — we have now reached the target of £12,000 for the restoration of the altar rails and £700 for a new plaque that will list the names of all the fallen of the parish who served in the "Great War" — to whom the altar rails (designed by Sir Giles Gilbert Scott) are dedicated. The pie and pea supper together with on going fundraising events are for the narthex that we hope to have built on the West end of the church. Fr Lawrence would like to thank everyone who has supported the fundraising events. Most especially he would like to say an enormous thank you to the members of the fundraising committee and those who have supported them and who have all worked very hard in organising events - very many thanks.
