This is the most important event in St Robert's church since its initial consecration on 31st July 1850. Bishop Seamus will celebrate the Mass of Consecration and there will be great festivities afterwards – a hog roast and lots of liquid refreshments. <u>This is purely a parish celebration and every parishioner is invited.</u>

On Monday afternoon he received a reply to say that they would be sent that very afternoon direct to the presbytery on the fastest post available. They arrive on Tuesday morning at 11.00am. Fr Lawrence is glad to announce that we have received the relics of St Maria Goretti, Virgin and Martyr; St Anthony of Padua, Doctor of the Church; and St Bernadette of Lourdes. These relics will be enshrined in three apertures in the base of the altar during the Mass of Consecration.
