Spire - The Diocese has approved the release of some of St. Robert's funds to carry out the masonry repairs to the Spire while scaffolding is in place.

Roof: - An application for a Grant under the Listed Places of Worship (LPOW) Roof Repairs Fund has been submitted. Answer expected at the end of March.

This excludes the work being carried out on the spire as we can't get cover for work carried out before any permission to spend is given by the HLF under their scheme. The roof has been included in that application in case we are not successful with the LPOW application. Answer expected in June.
